Sunday 4/20/08 & 10/5/08 Munich (Passau), Germany

Upon arrival, drop off your luggage and explore the cobblestone streets of Passau. If time permits, visit St. Stephen's Cathedral with one of the largest pipe organs in Europe. Embark on the *MV Mozart* at 4:30pm.

Monday 4/21/08 & 10/6/08 Durnstein and Vienna, Austria

Join us for a walking tour and marvel at the quaint 16th-century houses of Durnstein. This evening, enjoy a wonderful performance in Vienna which is being planned at this time.

Tuesday 4/22/08 & 10/7/08 Vienna, Austria

Our morning city tour will concentrate on the musical traditions that have helped to make Vienna so captivating. We will begin with the Theatre of Vienna where the *Magic Flute* was first played, and continue to the Stephansdom Cathedral, where Mozart was married. We will also visit the Figaro House, Mozart's home, where he wrote "The Marriage of Figaro." We will return to the *MV Mozart* for lunch.

In the afternoon, we will enjoy the finer details of the musical traditions born and nourished in Vienna, with a visit to the State Opera House and if available the Museum of Musical Instruments located in the Hofburg Palace. The collection consists of medieval and contemporary instruments, including an original piano from Ludwig van Beethoven.

Wednesday 4/23/08 & 10/8/08 Esztergom and Budapest, Hungary

This evening's performance will delight the senses as you are whisked off to the Hungarian State Opera House, or similar venue. The performance is to be announced.

Thursday 4/24/08 & 10/9/08 Budapest, Hungary

You will enjoy a wonderful city tour with a visit to the spectacular Parliament Building, the Opera and Fisher Bastion.

Friday 4/25/08 & 10/10/08 Bratislava

You will visit the 13th-century Bratislava Castle and the Gothic cathedral of St. Martin. You will also explore the Old Town Hall and the stunning Mirbach Palace.

Saturday 4/26/08 & 10/11/08 Melk and Grein

Our tour will take you to the magnificent Benedictine Monastery of Melk, a splendid example of Baroque architecture in Europe. Later, you can explore on your own the charming town of Grein to see Greinburg Castle, the Town Hall and the Franciscan Monastery.
